I recently completed an investigation of illegal mahogany logging in Peru and I thought you might be interested in our findings, described in the attached report. We found illegal logging of mahogany inside the Alto Purús National Park as well as in the indigenous lands and forestry concessions outside the park's borders. Unfortunately, despite mahogany's listing on Appendix II of CITES, this wood continues to be exported to the United States and Europe.
